In the Classroom

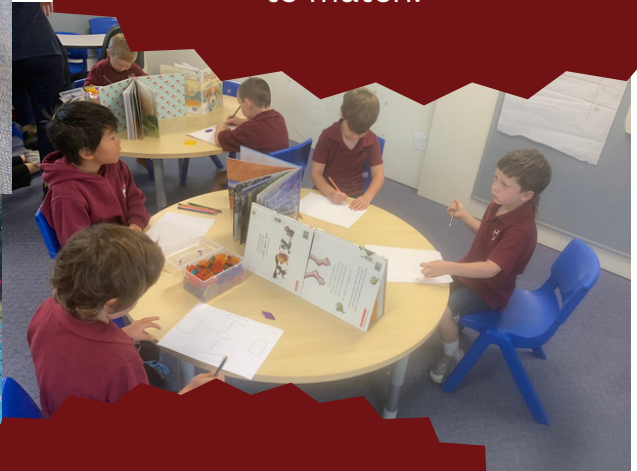
Senior Beach Day At Cape Conran
