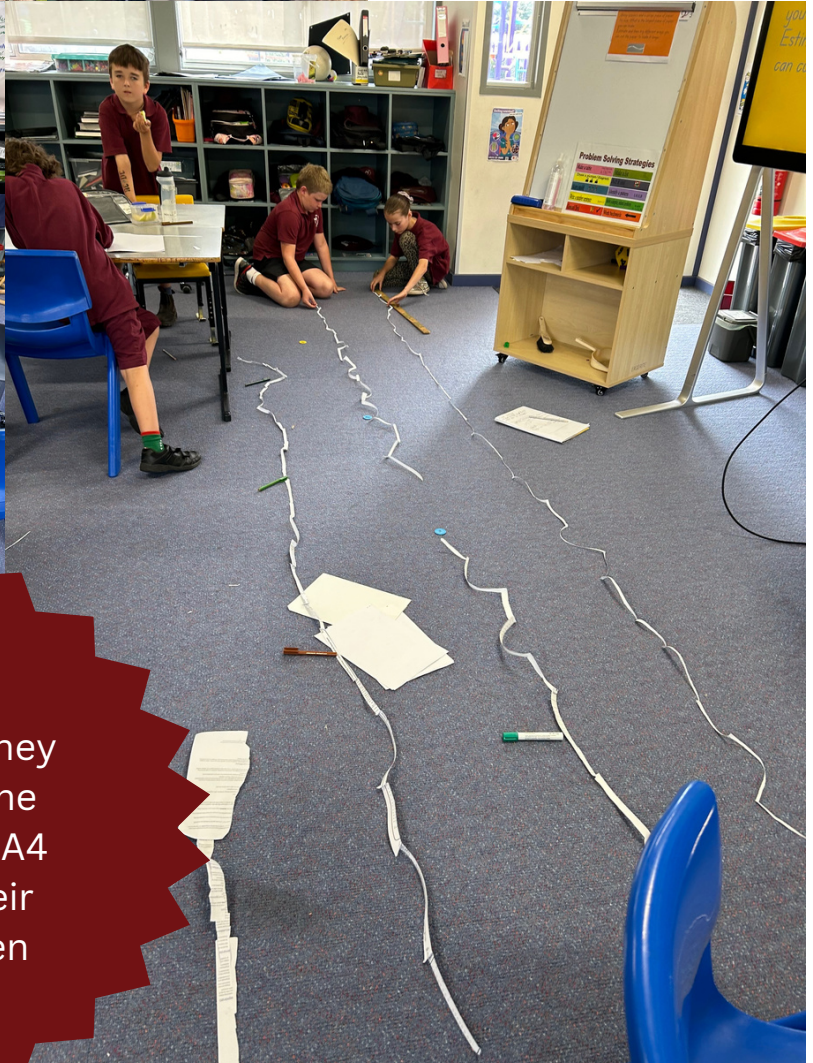




# In the Classroom

## 3-6 Numeracy

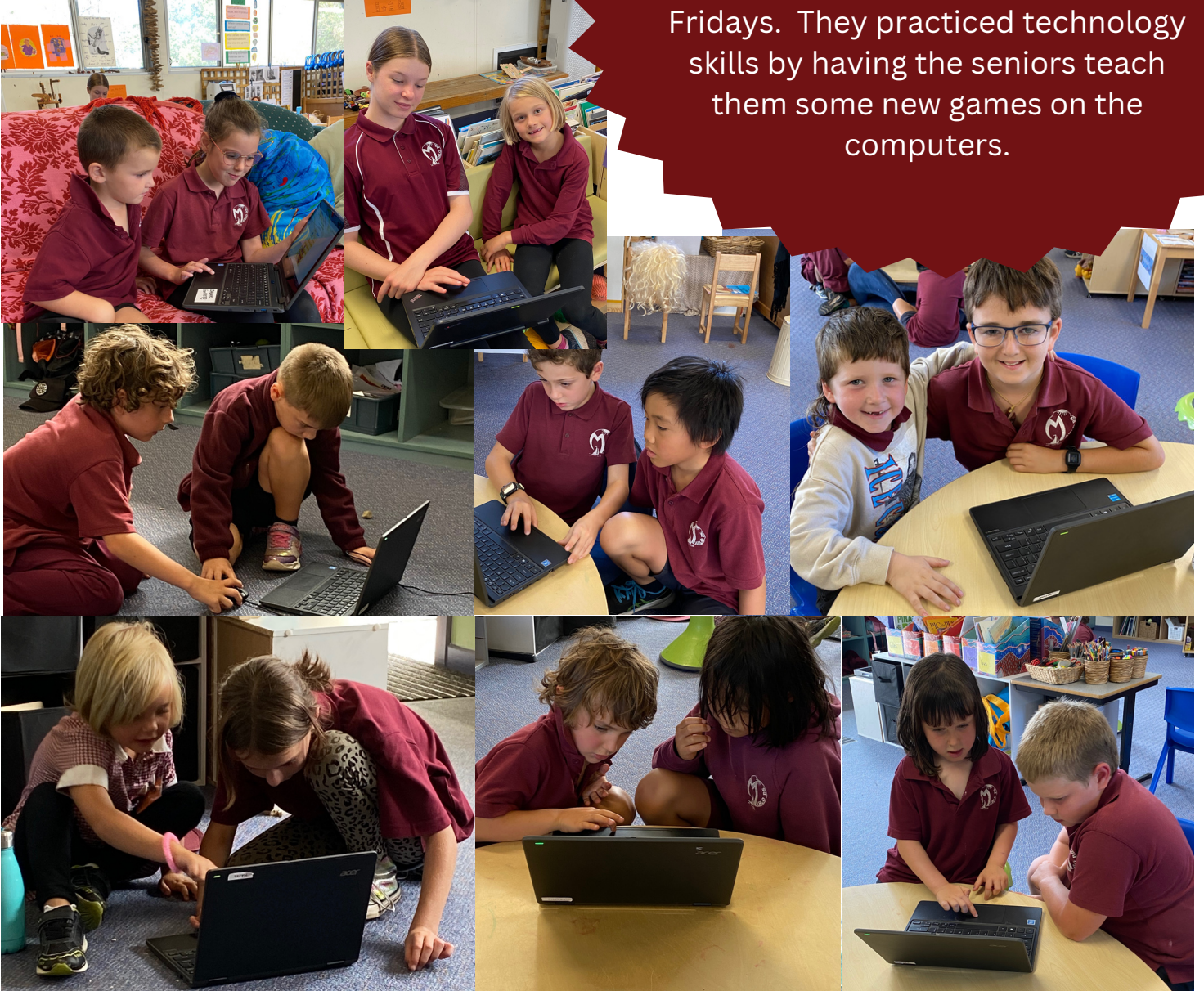
